

Insurance Requirements

To fulfill rental orders, Thunderstruck Pictures requires that our customers are insured, as evidenced by a current certificate of insurance. See our COI Sample ACORD 25 Form for details.

The policy must be valid for the full duration of your rental. It must include the pickup and return dates. On the insurance policy expiration date, all coverages expire at 12:01 AM standard time for whatever time zone the insurance company uses.

Required Liability Coverage

- Commercial General Liability \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$1,000,000 general aggregate.
- If filming outside the U.S.A. or Canada: Foreign Liability \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- If filming from an aircraft: Aircraft Liability \$5,000,000.
- If watercraft is involved in filming: Non-owned Watercraft Liability \$5,000,000.

Required Inland Marine Coverage

- Rented Production Equipment – Ask your rental representative for the total value of the equipment rented so your insurance agent can input the correct coverage limit.

Required Automobile Coverage If You Are Renting the Grip Truck

- Automobile Liability \$1,000,000 combined single limit (each accident)
- Automobile Comprehensive \$50,000 per vehicle
- Automobile Collision \$50,000 per vehicle

In the **Description of Operations** section of the COI form, it **MUST** say:

“Certificate holder is named as an Additional Insured with regard to liability insurance and as Loss Payee under the Inland Marine policy covering rented production equipment. Rented production equipment is covered for replacement cost. Equipment is covered in transit and at various locations. There is no exclusion for theft from an unlocked or unattended vehicle.”
